There are many scholarships that are available through the college and its partners, but this is the first of this kind, set up by the family and friends of such a fantastic teacher, who was a cornerstone of the school community for over 8 years. The fund will acknowledge and commemorate Kiah as a person who chose to give so much to education, Gilmore College and her students over her career. Her legacy lives on through the lives of the young women she guided through their teenage years. This scholarship aims to be a continuation of Kiah's commitment to mentoring those students who may otherwise get lost in the education system. Kiah's commitment for supporting both the educational and personal needs of her students was something she took on without the need to seek acknowledgement or approval but was an absolute credit to her personally.

Kiah is a sadly missed member of the school community. Her passion for education and her support of the 'underdog' was widely recognised by staff and students. She was always approachable and available to all and her friendly nature, good humour and strength of character will be an integral part of her legacy to the Kwinana community. The scholarship will be a pathway to future careers and opportunities for students who may otherwise not realise them.

The scholarship will be awarded to a female student who does not have the resources available to achieve her full potential, or complete her education, or both, at Gilmore College. It is not intended to be based on academic performance or the intended vocation. It was always Kiah's desire that all students be given the opportunity to complete their secondary education. This scholarship enables her family and friends to ensure that each year, one student from Gilmore College will benefit from her memory and ideals. The scholarship will be valued at up to \$2000 spread over Years 11 and 12.





Scholarship Terms & Conditions

Applicants must be:

- Australian citizens or permanent residents of Australia within the meaning of the Australian Citizen Act 2007 (proof of either must be provided if requested).
- Currently residing in the State of Western Australia.
- Completing Year 10, in the year of application, for Year 11 scholarships.
- Enrolled or prepared to enrol and complete Years 11 and/or 12 at Gilmore College, following the awarding of the scholarship.

"Kiah Rignall" Scholarship 2021-22

The Scholarship will be awarded to a female student in either Year 11 or Year 12 who may not have the resources available to achieve her full potential, or complete her education, or both at Gilmore College.

Applicants may be required to complete an Application Form and a provide a Letter of Application in which they explain:

- why they should be awarded the scholarship.
- how being awarded the scholarship would assist them.
- their intended Senior School studies.
- how they can make a positive contribution during their senior years at Gilmore College.
- their ambitions for the future

and submit the application by <u>3.00pm on Wednesday 22 September 2021 to Ms McCaig by email 'MCCAIG Lauren [Gilmore College]' Lauren.Mccaig@education.wa.edu.au</u>.

They should also be aware of their responsibilities as an applicant;

- to complete their application accurately and submit it on time;
- take responsibility for their semester 1 report and other documentation required for the application;
- check emails daily from the close of entry until notification of results;
- reply to emails relating to the scholarship process within 24 hours of receipt;
- be on time and prepared for the interview;
- direct questions relating to the scholarships, to the Year Co-ordinator Ms McCaig.
